RB HOT RISK, never far back, advanced while racing four wide through the turn and drew off late while being ridden out to the wire. FLY DUBAI CS broke sharply, dueled for the lead from three wide, was no match for the winner in the late stages but clearly second best. WMA SUCCESS SYMBOL stalked the pace while racing off the rail, swung four wide into the stretch and finished willingly. RB CREED saved ground and showed some late interest. WMA RED PEPPER, off slow and slow early, improved his position late. TTT CHARCOAL CHARLIE raced four wide into the stretch and only passed tired ones. RB HOT BUNS pressed the pace along the rail and tired after a half mile. HIJO DE SAMMY was away alertly, dueled for the lead from between rivals and tired in the final furlong. ALLEGRO FIRE, unhurried early, raced three wide into the lane and showed no rally.
